






OECD Regulatory Quality Indicators





Employment at General Government Sector from Population





What is on the Agenda: Culture Change

- Whistleblower protection
 - Development of a new, dedicated whistleblowing and whistleblower protection law
 - To apply to both public and private sector
 - Will promote creation of internal reporting channels including in business sector for workers to come forward with credible information about misconduct observed at workplace
- Public sector values and Code of Ethics
 - Development of an «umbrella regulation» setting out core values and principles of behaviour common to all public servants
 - Promoting practical application
- Horizontal cooperation between institutions
 - Cross-sectoral policies need cross-sectoral response
 strenghtening cooperation by removing legal, administrative barriers; best practice




What is on the Agenda: Regulatory Quality for Good Governance

- Annual state budget spending review
 - Our challenge: to create a methodology for evaluation of economy, efficiency and effectiveness of public spending
- Improvement of ex-ante impact assessment a step towards evidence-based decision making
 - Revision of framework to respond more precisely to policy aims and established results
- Development of Legal Drafts Information System
 - Announcement of legal drafts, coordination between institutions and review
 - Key: involvement of civil society, organisation of debates
- Introduction of ex-post impact assessment
 - Pilot projects to evaluate if the new framework contributes to the necessary outcomes
 - A tool to support international discussions such as EU and OECD
